

TOUR GUIDELINES

1. **ON OUR TOURS** – An emergency medical form should be carried by you. It should state your name, your medical insurance card, and prescriptions you take. For minor ailments an emergency **first aid kit** is aboard the bus. For each tour you will need to fill out an Emergency contact person slip to be kept with the host for that day.
2. Prior to the date of the tour be sure to verify the itinerary and the depart time. The depart time is the time the bus leaves with or without you. Please arrive 15 minutes before departure for day trips and 30 minutes before overnight trips so luggage can be put on the bus.
3. All tours normally start and end at: Lutheran Church of the Atonement on 1285 North New Florissant Road, in Florissant, Missouri. Please park to the right of the lot, away from the church entrance. No liability is assumed by the Lutheran Church of the Atonement or Atonement Seniors Alive.
4. **NEVER LEAVE THE TOUR AND GO ON YOUR OWN**, it is very wise to stay with a partner or small group during the tour. You leaving the tour could cause troubles and make the tour late for the next attraction. Keeping our tour schedule is very important. Have an itinerary sheet handy and be on time each time. We do not like leaving you behind so please stay with the group.
5. All guests are provided complementary name tags. Our custom is to collect the holder at the end of the tour but the name tag is yours to keep.
7. Bus seats are not assigned. We do ask that the front seats be reserved for the tours hosts and guest with special needs. Also if you have special needs please let the tour hosts know and every effort to accommodate will be made. If you have any problems on a tour, please let the tour host know and we will attempt to resolve all problems
8. Please – NO strong perfumes or lotions on the bus, some folks have allergies.
9. At restaurants; appetizers, desserts and alcoholic drinks are **on your own**. Non-scheduled Rest Stops purchases are **on your own**.
10. We are a senior group and we do plan our tours for seniors. There is no rock climbing or pushing the limit of things to do. However we do attempt to fill your day with activity.

THE MOST IMPORTANT RULE IS MAKE FRIENDS AND HAVE FUN SO MUCH YOU CANNOT WAIT TO GO ON THE NEXT TOUR.
